Earlier this spring, Meth-Wick Community announced to our residents that we were in need of additional space at The Woodlands. Since our occupancy levels are always high as our campus grows, the need for space also grows. Meth-Wick plans to add an addition that includes four specialty suites. Plans for that addition to the Lynch Neighborhood at The Woodlands have been submitted to the City of Cedar Rapids and to the State of Iowa for their approval.

The four specialty suites will be equipped to accommodate those who are non-weight bearing and bariatric individuals. Meth-Wick Community will be filling a niche in not only our community but also for the greater Linn County area, as these types of specialty suites are not widely available!

Our *Need for a Niche* campaign kicked off with the Meth-Wick residents and our major donors in March. *This may have been our fastest capital campaign ever – we have already reached our fundraising goal!* A big **THANK YOU** to all our contributors!

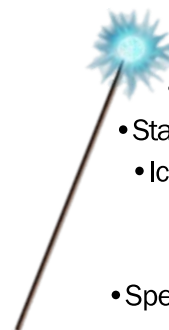
Meth-Wick plans to start construction on the Lynch addition early in June. Watch for the next issue with updates on the addition!
